Barns seem to be a very popular picking to break into. Please ensure that you have secured doors with high quality locks and where possible you have CCTV installed or a trail camera that has night vision and takes photos that have both time and date on them.

Serious damage is being caused to heritage assets, barrows and earth works in the Alfriston, Willingdon and Firle in particular. I am aware of similar incidents across other areas of Sussex. This damage often involves 4X4's being driven across heritage sites and farm land. If you witness such an event please call it in on the non-emergency number 101, or if criminal damage is taking place call 999. If possible please try and get details of the vehicle, make, model and colour and if convenient a photograph.
