Sussex Farm Watch Co-ordinator's Message

This week we've had reports of 18 horses and one gig loose on the highway. Two separate cases were reported of horses being hit by private cars, sadly in one case it resulted in the horse having to be put down.

Again this week we have seen a number of Land Rover thefts. An attempted theft in Battle was unsuccessful due to the vehicle being fitted with an immobiliser. There was however an amount of damage to the steering column and wiring. It is worth considering fitting ground anchors, trackers and motion sensors to these vehicles as well as tractors, quad bikes and other farm machinery.
